Sashes awarded for:	Definitions
❖ Best Exhibit in Show	CVA: colour variation allowed
❖ Grand Aggregate Winner in Show	Container: any number of stems
❖ Show Manager’s Favourite	Autumn Colours: must be turning to multi colours
	Summer Colours: self-colour only
	Horticultural Material: plant material living or dead. For example, weathered wood, dried leaves, fruit.

Home produce excluding handcrafts. Includes flowers, fruit, vegetables, etc. Preserve contents need not be home grown. Not to exceed 90 cm wide. Judged on presentation.

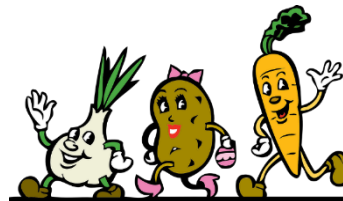
